# **Host City Information**

#### Salem

Salem is the fourth largest city in Tamil Na du. The city is surrounded by hills. In fact, the name Salem is derived from the word "Salam" meaning an area surrounded by mountains. Salem is also known as the "Steel City and "Mango City". The history of Salem dates back to the third century B.C. The city was a part of the Pandya, Pallava, and Vijayanagara Empires. After the defeat of Tipu Sultan in the Third Anglo-Mysore War in 1792, the State of Mysore's border was re-aligned, and the British formed the Salem district under Madras Presidency. Numerous forts and temples in the city date back to a previous era. Salem is a Geologist's paradise and is rich in a variety of important minerals like Magnesite, Dunite, Bauxite, Limestone, Iron ore, Quartz, Feldspar Soapstone, Granites, etc. As a district, Salem has its significance in various aspects. Salem is one of the major producers of traditional silver anklets, which are popular among women. Salem is a major textile center in Tamil Nadu and also houses a number of sago factories.



# **Places to Visit**

#### 1008 Lingam Temple – See one of Tamil Nadu's Oldest Shrines

We are sure that almost every Hindu of this country, especially a devotee of Lord Shiva will be aware of this temple in Salem. This temple is dedicated to Lord Shiva and is among the best tourist places in South India. There are 1008 Lingas together in the temple. 1007 Lingas are placed around one huge Linga. This huge Linga is of Nandi, the cow.

Location: Srinagar - Kanyakumari Highway, Ariyanur, Salem

#### Kalipatti Kandaswamy Temple – Marvel At The Architecture

This temple is also known as Kalipatti. The main deity worshipped in this temple is Murugan. This is one of the richest and oldest temples in this area. It was built in the 18th century. You can find a special kind of antidote here that is made of snake's poison. The antidote is known as Karun Sambal and is used to cure the devotees who come here. There are two chariots in the temple, namely Chitra Ther and Vinayaka Ther.

Location: Tiruchengode – Salem Main Rd, Kalipatti, Tamil Nadu

#### Sri Muthumalai Murugan Temple

The statue of Murugan was built by Tamil Malaysians. It took three years to construct, and was unveiled in January 2006 during Thaipusam festival. The managing authority of the temple rests with the Tamil descendants. Inspired by this statue, 146 ft tall Muthumalai Murugan Statue was sculpted in Salem district of Tamil Nadu in 2022.

Location: Distance between the temple and Salem's main city is 40 kilometers

#### Sri Rajaganapathi Temple

The Rajaganapathi Temple is located in Salem and is dedicated to God Rajaganapathi. The temple is believed to have been constructed 400 years ago. Kings considered God Vinayaka as a force that would defend them from evil. Since the region was hilly with forests, it was then known as Shaila Desam. The famous Sugavaneswarar temple is situated very close to this temple. The temple is about 2 km away from the Salem bus stand and it is nearer to Sugavaneswarar Temple.

Location: Mariappan Nagar, Salem, Tamil Nadu 636003

**Timings** : 6:00 am to 10:30 pm

#### **Mettur Dam**

The Mettur Dam is one of the largest dams in India and also the largest in Tamil Nadu, located across the river Kaveri where it enters the plains. Built in 1934, it took 9 years to complete. Maximum height and width of the dam are 214 and 171 feet, respectively. The dam receives inflows from its own catchment area, Kabini Dam and Krishna Raja Sagara Dams located in Karnataka. There is a park at the base of the dam called Ellis Park maintained by the Tamil Nadu Public Works Department.

Location: 60 km from Salem

#### Mookaneri Lake - Go Boating

This is one of the most beautiful lakes that one can find in Tamil Nadu. The city to Salem is blessed for being the home to such a beautiful water body. This lake is spread in an area of 58 acres. It was earlier spread in 39 hectares, but a lot of money was spent on it in the year 2012 for the reconstruction. This picaresque location is the home of a variety of birds and flora.

Location: Kannankurichi Main Road, Kannankurichi



The mountainous town of Yercaud is located in Tamil Nadu's Salem district. It is situated in the mountain range of Shevaroy Mountain in the Eastern Ghats. Sarvarayana Temple, which rises 5326 feet above sea level and is located at 1515 meters above sea level, is the highest point in Yercaud. It is one of Yercaud's most popular tourist attractions.


