alem is the fourth largest city in Tamil Nādu. The city is surrounded by hills. In fact, the name Salem is derived from the word "Sailem" meaning an area surrounded by mountains. Salem is also known as the "Steel City and "Mango City".

The history of **Salem** dates back to the third century B.C. The city was a part of the Pandya, Pallava, and Vijayanagara Empires. After the defeat of Tipu Sultan in the Third Anglo-Mysore War in 1792, the State of Mysore's border was realigned, and the British formed the Salem district under Madras Presidency.


Numerous forts and temples in the city date back to a previous era. Salem is a Geologist's paradise and is rich in a variety of important minerals like Magnesite, Dunite, Bauxite, Limestone, Iron ore, Quartz, Feldspar Soapstone, Granites, etc. As a district, Salem has its significance in various aspects. Salem is one of the major producers of traditional silver anklets, which are popular among women. Salem is a major textile center in Tamil Nadu and also houses a number of sago factories.











PLACES TO VISIT IN SALEM

Yercaud

The mountainous town of Yercaud is located in Tamil Nadu's Salem district. It is situated in the mountain range of Shevaroy Mountain in the Eastern Ghats. Sarvarayana Temple, which rises 5326 feet above sea level and is located at 1515 meters above sea level, is the highest point in Yercaud. It is one of Yercaud's most popular tourist attractions. The climate is ideal, and Yercaud is home to several coffee fields. Yercaud Lake is the area's main attraction. One of the region's major attractions is the May summer festival. It is devoted to Lord Sarvarayana, the supreme God of the mountains.

Location: located near Shevaroy Hills (also known as Shevarayan Hills), which is about 5 km from Yercaud Lake. Salem, Tamil Nadu 637503

Kalangi Siddhar Temple - Pay Your Respects

If you know anything about Tamil Nadu or the religious things related to the state, then you must be aware of the fact that there are 18 Tamil Siddha temples. The best part about these temples is that all of them are located in Salem. Kalangi Siddhartha Temple is one of them. This temple is not just holy but is very beautiful too. There are small streams and water bodies around the temple. These add to the beauty and charm of the temple. It is said that the water of these streams has curative powers and if you take a dip into it, then it could curate various problems of yours. There are regular pujas offered here and you can visit the place any time you want to become a part of it.

Mettur Dam

The Mettur Dam was constructed across the river Cauvery which originates in Mercara of Coorg District in Karnataka State at 4400 feet above M.S.L and confluence with Bay of Bengal. The total length of river Cauvery is 812 Kms. This reservoir benefits Salem, Namakkal, Erode, Karur, Trichy, Ariyalur, Thriuvarur, Thanjavur, Nagapattinam, Pudukottai Districts. Mettur, Edappadi, sangagiri, Thiruchengode and Bhavani taluks are benefitted by this reservoir.

Mookaneri Lake - Go Boating

This is one of the most beautiful lakes that one can find in Tamil Nadu. The city to Salem is blessed for being the home to such a beautiful water body. This lake is spread in an area of 58 acres. It was earlier spread in 39 hectares, but a lot of money was spent on it in the year 2012 for the reconstruction. This picaresque location is the home of a variety of birds and flora. You can just get the best of nature after coming to this place. The lake is situated near a residential area. So, one could see a lot of families coming here in the evening and in the morning time. You can also call it a picnic spot. There is a fine arrangement of parking and seating over there. So, if you are visiting it, you won't face any such problems.

1008 Lingam Temple - See One Of Tamil **Nadu's Oldest Shrines**


We are sure that almost every Hindu of this country, especially a devotee of Lord Shiva will be aware of this temple in Salem. This temple is dedicated to Lord Shiva and is among the best tourist places in South India. There are 1008 Lingas together in the temple. 1007 Lingas are placed around one huge Linga. This huge Linga is of Nandi, the cow. There is this huge idol of Lord Ganesha on the entrance. As soon as you enter the main temple, you can see the huge idol of the main deity, who is Sri Umayambigai Sametha Sri Arunachala Sundareswara. It's not just the temple that is beautiful from inside only, but the surrounding of this temple too is very beautiful. It has Sankagiri Mountains at the back of it and it makes the entire surrounding more beautiful.

This temple is also known as Kalipatti. The main deity worshipped in this temple is Murugan. This is one of the richest and oldest temples in this area. It was built in the 18th century. You can find a special kind of antidote here that is made of snake's poison. The antidote is known as Karun Sambal and is used to cure the devotees who come here. There are two chariots in the temple, namely Chitra Ther and Vinayaka Ther. There is this world-famous cattle fair organized in this temple in January. At that time, both these Chariots are moved all around the temple. The festival in which the cattle fair is held is known as Thaipusam Festival.

Oothumalai Hill - Trek To The Top
